SHOW DESCRIPTIONS

Attainable Goals is a narrative Improv show. We'll start the show by conducting an audience interview. We'll find out how the audience member (or their friends) would describe themselves, and then ask them about a goal they'd like to reach. The show will be the improvisers playing the audience member reaching their goal with hilarious hijinks.

Check, Please! Dating can be hard. Especially when your date happens to be not quite what you imagined. *Check, Please!* follows a series of blind dates that couldn't get any worse... until they do.

Discovery Town: Bryan is an old-school tour guide at the newly re-built and re-branded provincial historic site, Discovery Town. When he welcomes a class of students for a routine education tour, things don't go as planned. But don't worry, Bryan knows what to do to keep his tour from un-ravelling. The same might not be true for his sanity.

MINE! True Stories and Legends of the Porcupine Gold Rush is a 12-song, journey back in time to a world of prospectors, pioneers, bootlegger-bandits, dog-sledders and moonshiners. Singer-Songwriter, Actor and Playwright Will Gillespie shares stories from Canadian history with new, original Folk songs, digging deep to uncover hidden gems of the past.

OOPS! A Nuclear Fallout explores a 2020 false alarm from the Pickering Nuclear plant. An event that had many Ontarians shaken and panicked and the rest silencing their phones in indifference as we began to become aware of the failing social good of social media. LOL. Who's Pickering? Hope she's okay.

THEATRE IS DEAD is not a show: it is a eulogy. Forget performance. Forget drama. Forget art. Welcome to the future. The Digital Age. The land of cell phones, and Insta-perfect lives, and five-minute attention spans. The theatre, as we know it, is gone. But the show... the show must go on.

The Elvis in Her: A love letter to Elvis Presley. The story of his life and the dreams he dared to dream.

The Inevitable Frankie Green: In an icy tent behind the last McDonald's before the highway going North, Frankie Green and his sister Eva drift through their bleak existences on the periphery of North Bay society. Lately, his spiralling life has gone further off the rails as the barriers between time and space have seemingly begun to crumble under his feet. And the sudden appearance of the otherworldly William Beaumont isn't helping either.

The Way of the Eye: In an abstract realm of movement and emotion, two masked knights from opposing families fall instantly in love. Each with an array of puppet companions seeking to keep them apart, conflicts escalate, resulting in the manifestation of Death. The knights seek to be married. Will hope and love triumph? Or will this pursuit of happiness end in tears?

To Torture a Prince is an abstract, satirical drama based on the life, writings and misfortunes of the Italian diplomat, writer and philosopher, Niccolò Machiavelli. This piece looks at his beliefs revolving around power and diplomacy after his wrongful torture and imprisonment in 1512.
